Please proceed down the center aisle, break off a piece of bread, dip it in the cup on the side on which you are seated, and return to your seat via the side aisle. A gluten-free communion station is provided to the left. If mobility or health concern is an issue for you, there are self-serve cups available at the entrance to the sanctuary.

A "LONGEST NIGHT" SERVICE will be held in the chapel on Wednesday, December 21st at 6:00 p.m. The service is traditionally held on the longest night of the year and recognizes that the Christmas season can be a painful and lonely time for some. It is designed to offer comfort and hope to those experiencing loneliness, depression, loss, isolation, and anguish. All are invited, particularly those who have experienced a loss of some kind in the previous year and those who want to stand in the place of darkness with others.

OUR CHRISTMAS EVE CAROL AND CANDLELIGHT SERVICE is Saturday. Dec. 24th at 5:30 p.m. We will observe a service of Lessons & Carols as we celebrate the birth of our Lord. Pre-service music will begin at 5:10 p.m.


