ADVENT GIFT FOR CHILDREN AND YOUTH: Today we have an Advent gift for all children and youth. These gifts will be given out before and after the worship service. These gifts are for all children – both members and visitors.

OUR CHRISTMAS EVE CAROL AND CANDLELIGHT SERVICE is Saturday, Dec. 24th at 5:30 p.m. We will observe a service of Lessons & Carols as we celebrate the birth of our Lord. Pre-service music will begin at 5:10 p.m.

A "LONGEST NIGHT" SERVICE will be held in the sanctuary this Wednesday, December 21st at 6:00 p.m. The service is traditionally held on the longest night of the year and recognizes that the Christmas season can be a painful and lonely time for some. It is designed to offer comfort and hope to those experiencing loneliness, depression, loss, isolation, and anguish. All are invited, particularly those who have experienced a loss of some kind in the previous year and those who want to stand in the place of darkness with others.

WORSHIP ON CHRISTMAS DAY: Christmas Day falls on a Sunday this year. Our worship that morning will be an informal service and we ask everyone to sit in the front half of the sanctuary. We will sing Christmas hymns and Pastor Tim will read a Christmas story. The service will last approximately 30 minutes, after which we will gather for a time of fellowship with hot cider and cookies.
