COVID PRECAUTION PHASES: At its regularly stated meeting on August 17th, the Session of 2nd Presbyterian Church implemented four Covid Precaution Phases. The phases are tied to the 7-Day Average Covid-19 Percent Positive Tests data provided by the Knox County Health Department. These phases will provide for the safety, health, and well-being of our membership and our visitors, given the level of Covid transmission in Knox County. Information on the phases is available on the home page of our website and in the September *2nd Edition*. Signs on the doors of the church building and the banner on the top of our website will indicate the current phase. **We are currently in Phase Red.**

DISCIPLESHIP

WEDNESDAY NIGHT BIBLE STUDY HAS RESUMED on Wednesdays at 6:30 p.m. When we are in Covid Phase Red, there will be no dinner and the class will take place virtually. Once we have returned to Covid Phase Orange, the Bible Study will be in-person with a virtual option for those who wish to join from home. We will also gather for dinner at 6:00 p.m. during Covid Phase Orange, but a prepared meal will not be served. Instead, we invite those who desire to gather for dinner with each person/family providing their own "brown bag" dinner. When we return to Covid Phase Yellow, a prepared meal will be provided at 6:00 p.m., followed by the Bible study at 6:30 p.m.

This fall we are studying *The Kingdom Parables of Jesus*, those parables in which Jesus says, "The Kingdom of Heaven is like..." The format is lecture/small group discussion. Pastor Tim will review the story for 20 minutes or so then we break into small groups for discussion questions together. The discussion questions are provided.
