About the Preschool...

Our purpose is to provide quality child-care to the community that fosters the development of the whole child to his or her full potential as a child of God. We are open from 7:30 a.m.-5:30p.m. Monday – Friday. We serve children from 6 weeks to 5 years of age. Low staff child ratios enable the teachers to provide an environment conducive to exploring all developmental areas.

Full-Time Five Days Per Week

We encourage you to enroll your child in a full-time program to allow them the best opportunity to adjust to a regular routine.

Because the staff/child ratio is higher in infants, toddlers and twos, a higher fee is charged for those under three years of age.

Part-Time

Parents have the option to enroll their child either to attend Monday/Wednesday/Friday or Tuesday/Thursday, depending on space availability.

Fee Schedule

There is a \$25.00 non-refundable application fee due at the time of applying for care. There is also a \$100.00 materials fee that is due in September. This fee will be prorated for those beginning in all other months.

All payments are made on a monthly basis. Tuition is due on the first of each month and will be considered late after the fifth working day. A late fee will be charge after the fifth.

Table food is provided by the preschool. Morning, afternoon snack and a daily hot lunch are included in the tuition amounts.

WAITING LIST AND RESERVING OPENINGS

Holding openings for children who already have siblings in the program and for church member and church staff is as follows:

- There is a grace period of one month with no tuition charge.
- Half tuition will be charged starting with the second month if the parents wish to reserve the opening.
- Full tuition will be charged starting with the third month if the parents wish to reserve the opening.

Holding openings for children who are new enrollees and do not have a sibling in the program is as follows:

- Pay full tuition starting with the day the hold begins.

Please note that we do close with Knox County inclement weather closings.
